

5. Without that conscious Christ Connection we lose opportunities to receive divine ideas [fish]. 6. As in our previous states of awareness if our consciousness [net] is Truth-centered [throw nets on the right] our ability to remain in the world but not of the world [boat], will provide opportunities to receive many divine ideas [a large catch of fish], ideas which will help us master the art of living on any plane of being.

\* *There are many planes of consciousness. As we matriculate through each plane (dimension of cosmic awareness) we need to remember that we are the Christ expressing Itself as us no matter how many dimensions of being [schools] we choose to experience.*

# *A Great Catch of Fish*

*John 21:1-6 ~ From a Metaphysical Perspective*

1. Once we move beyond the illusion of duality and separation and see consciousness as the ground of all being [a Sea of Tiberius perspective] we have reached that exalted state of cosmic awareness [the Jesus Christ of us] which defines our new level of spiritual unfoldment.
2. The spiritual qualities which are particularly helpful at this juncture in our enlightenment are unequivocal faith [the Simon Peter of us], cosmic intelligence [the Thomas of us], and total openness and receptivity to cosmic truths [our Nathanael quality]. These three qualities would have remained unknown to us at a lower vibration [our Cana capacity]. Other highly-charged spiritual qualities are also present, such as a high degree of inviolate wisdom [our James, Son of Zebedee quality]; love raised to its universal resonance [our James, son of Zebedee quality]; enthusiastic, but controlled zealousness [our Simon the Zealot quality]; and illumined imagination [the Bartholomew of us] that keep us energized and expectant as we explore our expanded thought universe.
3. As we explore the limitlessness of our super-heated awareness, it is important to remember that even though we are operating at a super-conscious level with enhanced spiritual abilities, we must not allow our inviolate faith [the Simon Peter of us] to slip back into impetuous faith. Seeking divine ideas [fish] at a fully-Christed level of awareness means honoring our Christ Connection. It means affirming our good from the awareness of our oneness with the Eternal Isness (the One Reality, the Infinite Indivisibleness) as we advance through each plane\* of consciousness. If we neglect to do that, we will find that putting our ego first on any plane of being limits our continued spiritual growth [they caught no fish].
4. Depending solely on our incarnational 'resumés' [the disciples did not recognize Jesus] as we become acclimated at each cusp of consciousness [early in the morning] keeps the vital energies of our Christ Self dormant [Jesus stood on the shore].
